VACANCY FOR THE POSITION OF MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NAIROBI METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORT AUTHORITY- THREE (3) POSITIONS

The Nairobi Metropolitan Area Transport Authority was established vide Legal Notice No. 18 of 17th February 2017 and is responsible for overseeing the establishment of an integrated, efficient, effective and sustainable public transport system within the Nairobi Metropolitan Area. In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 (2), of the Legal Notice the Council declares three (3) vacancies for positions of members of the Board of Directors of the Nairobi Metropolitan Area Transport Authority.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Duties and Responsibilities of Members of the Board of Directors include:

1. Approving and overseeing the implementation of an integrated Transport Master Plan;
2. Overseeing the development of a sustainable, evidentially based, Integrated Mass Rapid Transit System Strategy;
3. Formulating additional standards and requirements for Mass Rapid Transit System and monitoring their delivery;
4. Partnering with public sector agencies and other parties for the development and operation of transportation infrastructure;
5. Regulating and entering into agreements with Mass Rapid Transit System Operators and Service Providers;

6. Recommending to the Council transport corridors to be declared as part of the Authority's Strategic Transport Network ;
7. Ensuring compliance of any law or regulation on the functions of the Authority;
8. Approving traffic management schemes and accesses along the declared corridors; and
9. Performing any other function vested upon the Board.

Requirements for Appointment

A Person shall be qualified to be a Member of the Board if such person:-

1. Is a Citizen of Kenya;
2. Is not a Public Officer;
3. Holds a degree or its equivalent from a recognized University and has knowledge and experience in any of the following:-
 - a) Transport;
 - b) Law;
 - c) Intelligent transport Systems;
 - d) Civil engineering;
 - e) Traffic engineering;
 - f) Economics;
 - g) Urban design, planning and management; or
 - h) Any other relevant field. *A Master's degree will be an added advantage.*
4. Must have knowledge and experience at least six (6) years in a relevant field; and
5. Meets the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution.

Terms of Service and Benefit;

The Members of the Board shall be appointed on a non-executive position for a term of three (3) years and will be eligible for re-appointment for an additional one term.

How to Apply

- a) Each application should be accompanied by a detailed curriculum vitae, testimonials, copies of relevant academic and professional certificates, testimonials and other relevant supporting documents.
- b) A copy of the National Identity Card.
- c) Attach Clearance Certificates from Criminal Investigations Department, Kenya Revenue Authority, Higher Education Loans Board and Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission.
- d) All applications should be clearly marked “**Application for the position of Member of the Board, Nairobi Metropolitan Area Transport Authority**” and submitted in any ONE of the following ways; should be received on or before **4th April 2017**.
