8. Tenderers sought clarification on the Bid bond type.

9. Tenderers sought clarification on logistics of decommissioning the old lifts.

Tenderers were advised that the decommissioning process shall be as described in the Bills of Quantities with minimal interference to day-to-day office operations for the Procuring entity.

Tenderers requested for extension of tender submission deadline.
