REPORT

The air accident investigations department was informed about an aircraft incident involving a Hawker Seddeley type of aircraft at Wilson airport at 1630 on 8/4/2014 and the investigator was dispatched to the site on 09/04/2014 at 0500 to establish the circumstances leading to the incident.

On 08/04/2014 at around 1537, a Hawker Siddeley type of aircraft registration 5Y-BVQ owned by HS748 and operated by Global Airlift Ltd experienced multiple tyre burst on starboard side landing gear while landing on runway 07 at Wilson airport on a flight test for the purpose of issuance of certificate of airworthiness. The aircraft had taken off from the same airport.

The occurrence caused a temporary closure of the airport as the aircraft had blocked both runways rendering them unusable. The aircraft however, the aircraft was towed from the site to apron 4 after replacing the faulty wheels.

Investigations into the accident are ongoing.
