REMARKS

At approximately 1042 on 08 September 2016, the Air Accident Investigation Department was notified of an occurrence at Airspray airstrip, Naivasha, Nakuru County.

The report indicated that the aircraft crashed and caught fire shortly after takeoff with six occupants; one suffered fatal injuries, one had serious injuries and four escaped with minor injuries.

There was a post-crash fire and the aircraft completely engulfed by the inferno.

Investigation is in progress.
